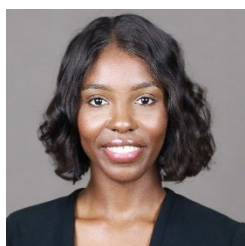
DR. WILLIAM AND NANCY LASCHEID MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS

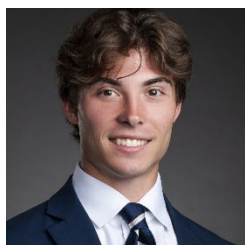

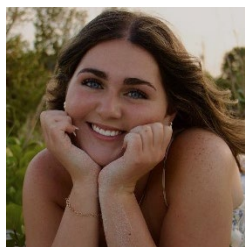
